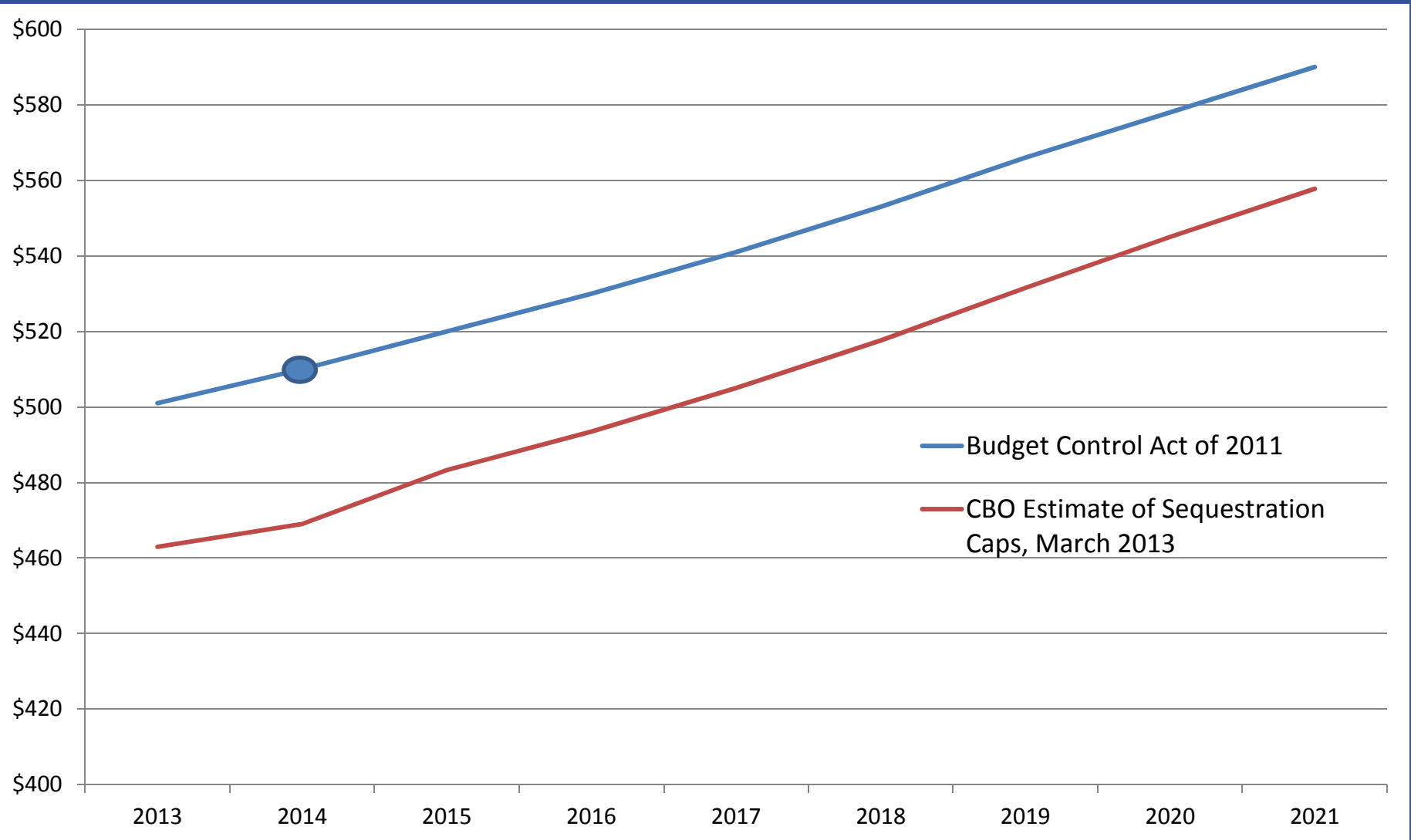


Sequestration Recap

The National Institutes of Health (NIH) yesterday warned about the damage of \$1.5 billion in automatic cuts to all federal agencies starting in March. NIH Director Francis Collins (D-MD) said the so-called sequestration would slow scientific progress, delay clinical trials, and put a generation of young researchers at risk if NIH's \$31 billion budget for this year is trimmed by \$1.5 billion.

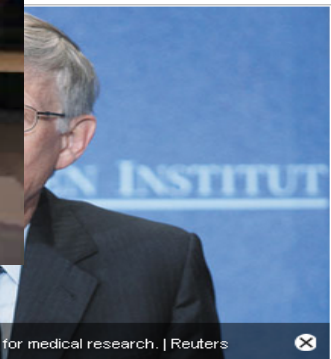
