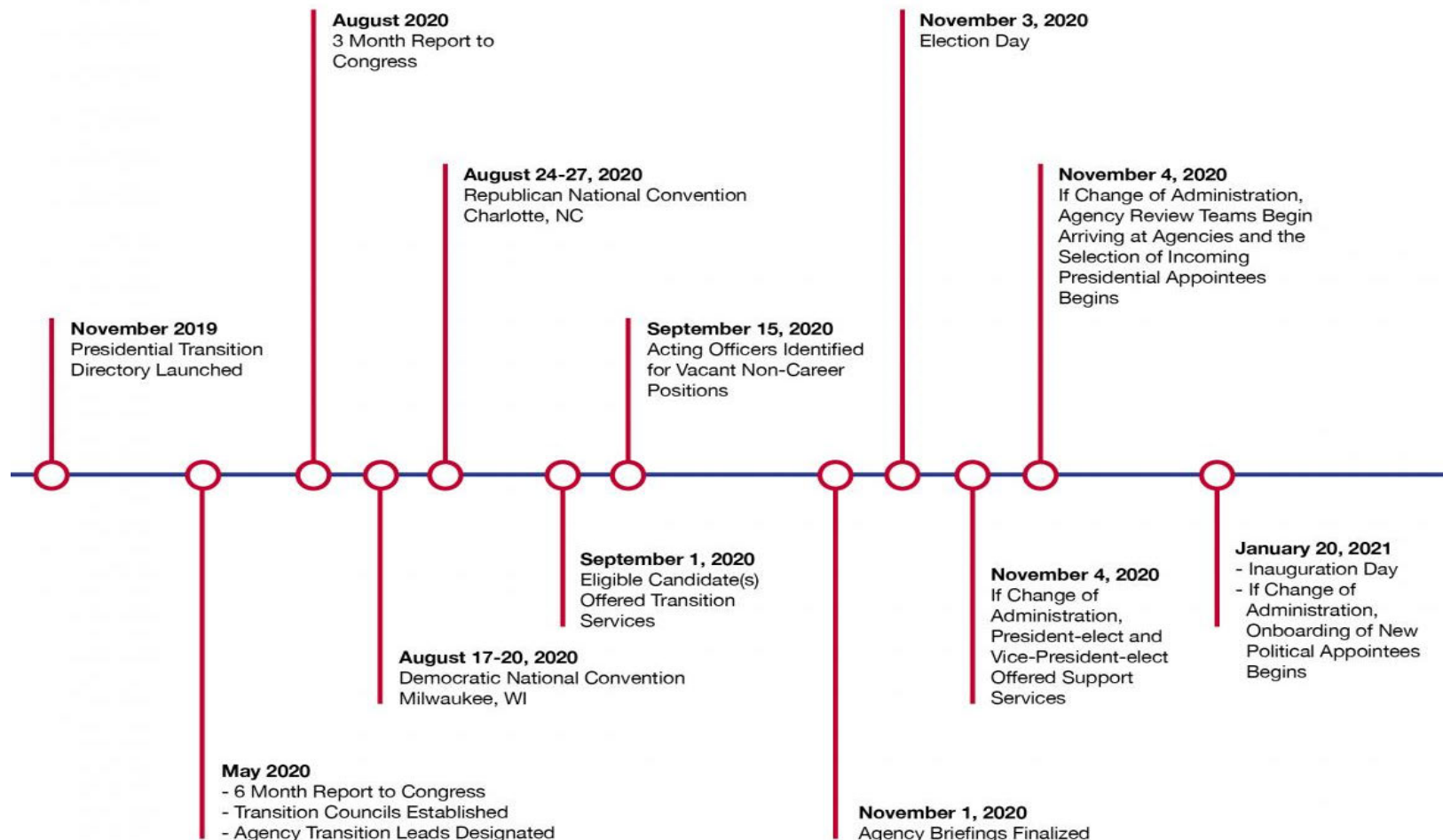

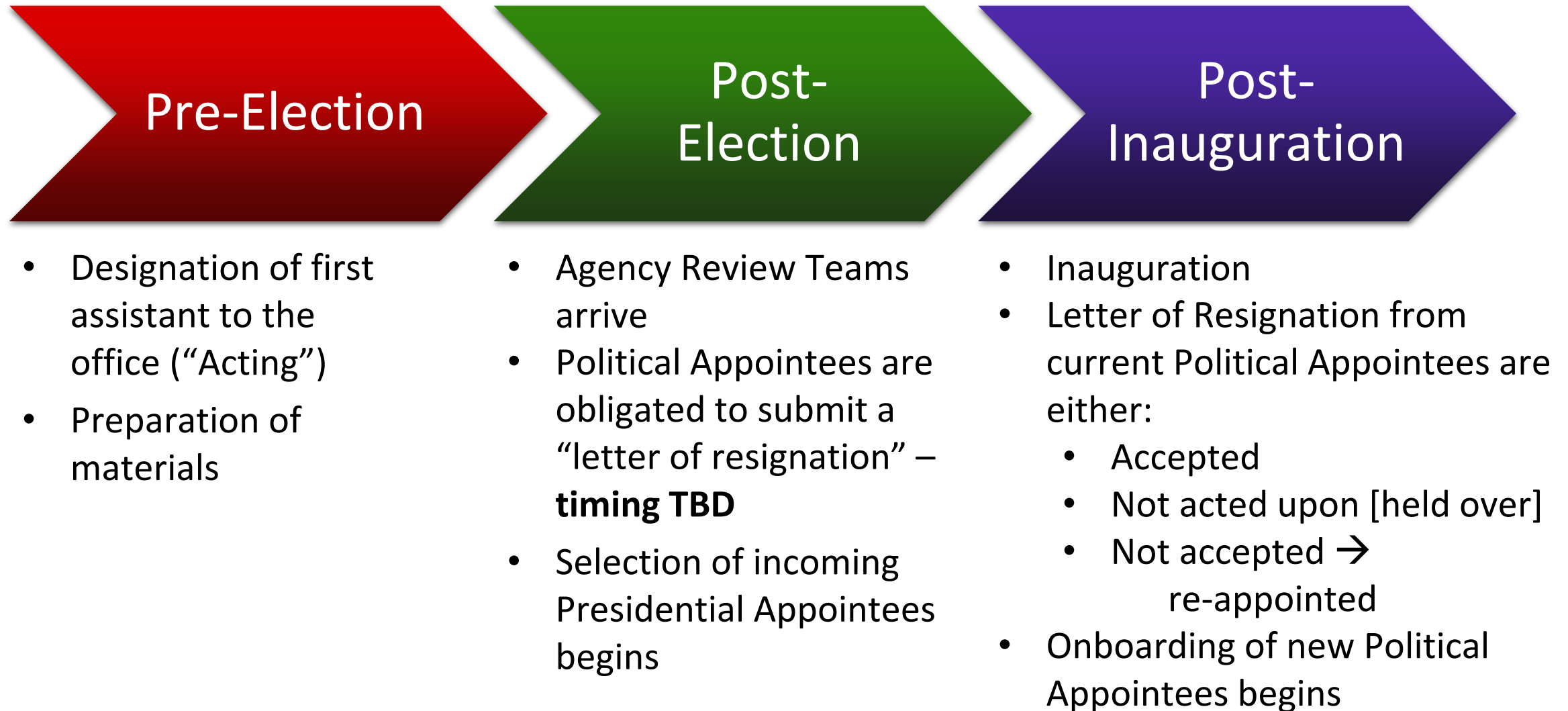

PRESIDENTIAL TRANSITION PROCESS Major Activities Timeline (2019/2021)



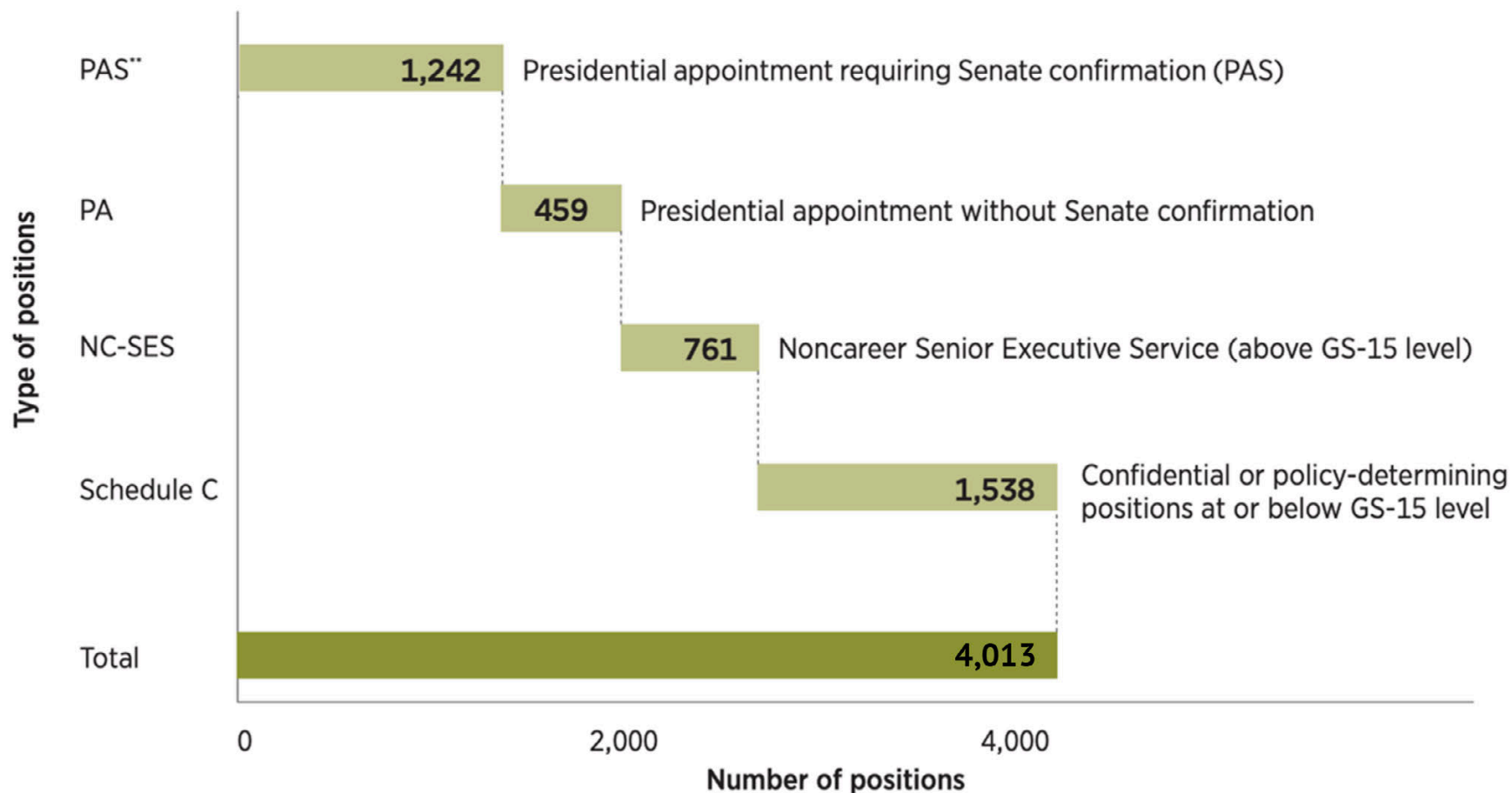
A New Administration: Presidential Transition



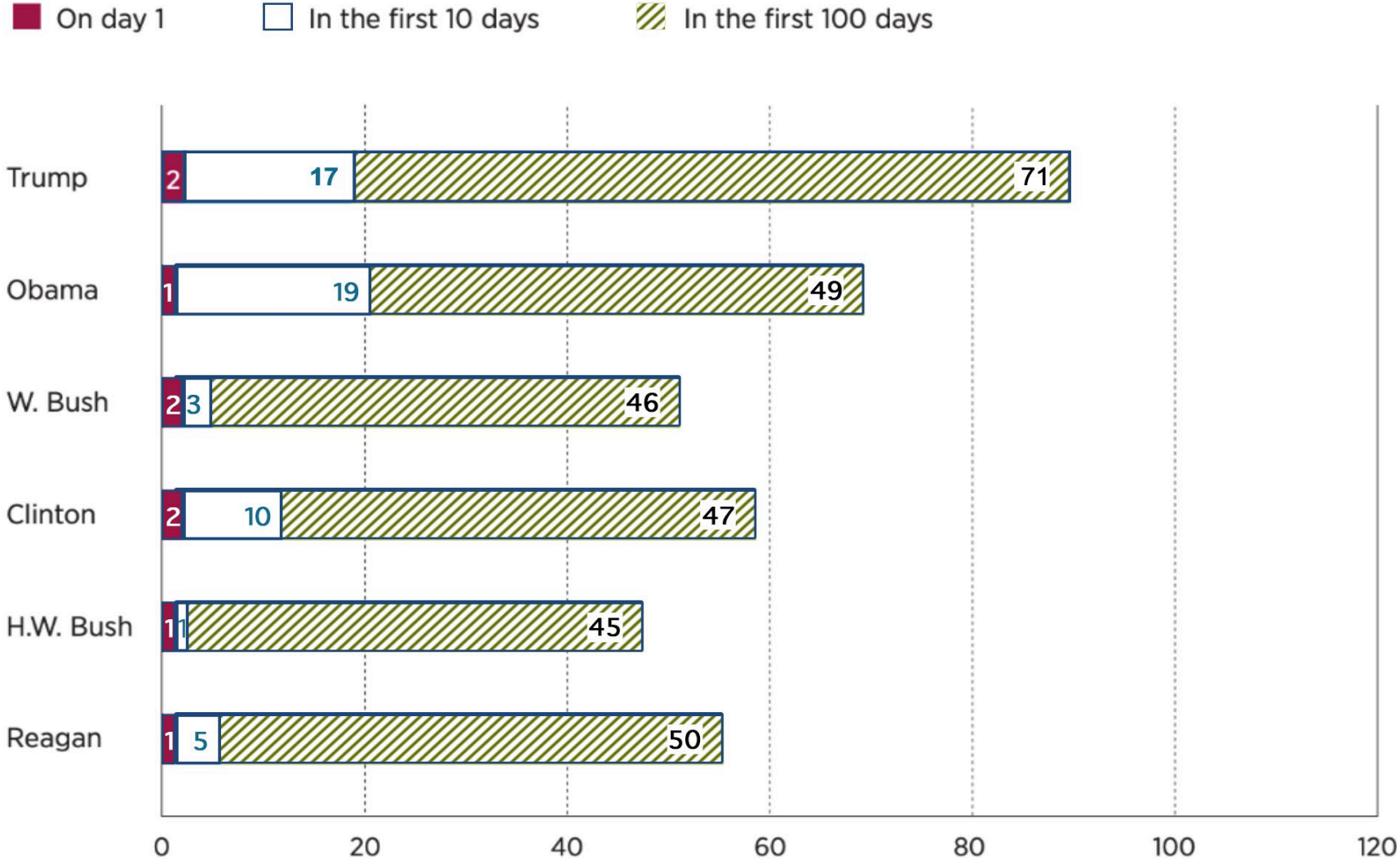
Personnel Planning – Political

Types of noncompetitive positions*

A new administration typically makes ~4,000 appointments. Over 1,100 can require Senate confirmation.



Executive actions issued by modern presidents in the first 100 days



Transition Leadership Across Government



White House Transition Coordinating Council (WHTCC)

Provides overall oversight and guidance to agencies on transition activity



GSA Transition Coordinator

Liaison between the WHTCC and federal agencies on transition; Coordinates activities of federal agencies



Agency Transition Directors Council

Comprised of the senior leader of transition activities at each agency and the GSA Transition Coordinator; ensures coordination across agencies



HHS Transition Team

Composed of leadership at HHS (OSG, OGC, ASA, ASFR); manage the transition for HHS



HHS Presidential Transition Council

Composed of representatives from each OPDIV and STAFFDIV (LAT and TAS represent NIH)

Owner's Manual

- **Detailed briefing book** with information on the function, organization, key personnel, administrative operations, budget, and legal, legislative, and regulatory data
- **First 90 days** - Identifying critical decisions that new appointees will need to make and include **Quick Wins and identify land mines**

Agency Review Team Briefing Book – 7 Pages

- **High level overview** summarizing highest priority issues - incorporate the “So What”
- **First 90 days** - Identifying critical decisions that new appointees will need to make and include **Quick Wins and identify land mines**

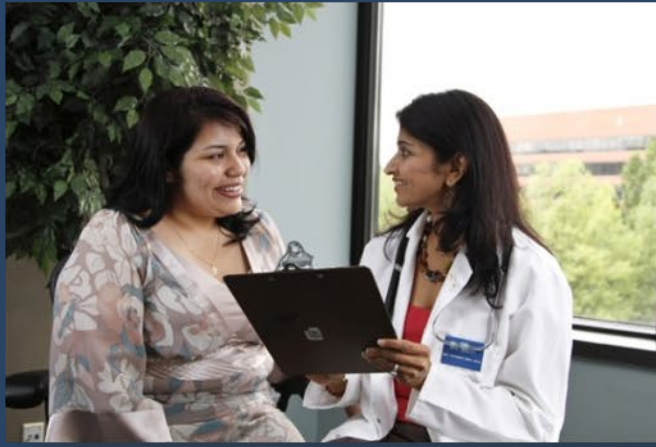
